

Southern Trails Wickecheoke Preserve 1,295 +/- acres

The Donald and Beverley Jones Memorial Footpath meanders on and off quiet country roads, connecting preserved lands along the creek.

Numerous bike racks and parking pull-offs can be accessed along the trail, making it suitable for bikers, leisurely drivers, and walkers. Trail-head signs are located where the trail crosses from preserved land onto roads. Maps are posted at these trail-heads.

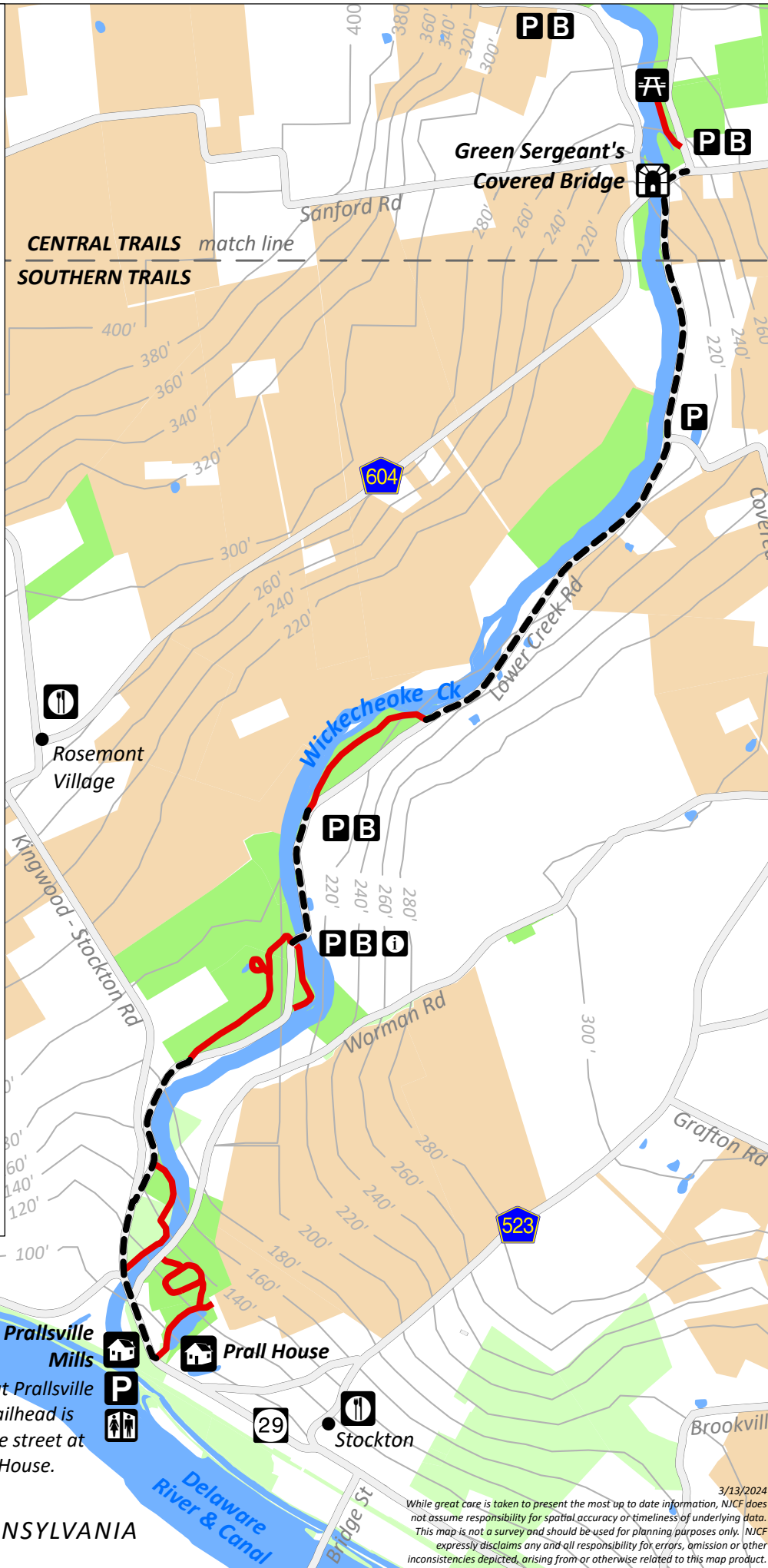
